



CLUB DETAILS

- All Junior Jets clubs will meet once per week from 3:30-4:30pm with the exception of Musical Theater Club, which will meet twice per week on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- The Spring session will run for 12 weeks beginning the week of February 3-7 and ending the week of April 28-May 2. No clubs will meet March 17-21 (Spring Break week) and the make-up week will be May 5-9.
- Club registration will begin Wednesday, December 11 and end Wednesday, January 15. Late registration will not be accepted.
- Club fees are non-refundable.
